But this is no doubt possible in regard to judgement of generations, even if we cannot perceive anything good in a book which has been admired and praised for hundreds of years. We may be sure that by trying, by studying it carefully, we shall at last be able to feel the reason of this admiration and praise. The best of all libraries for a poor man would be a library entirely composed of such great works only, books which have passed the test of 6 time.
