The British Constitutional system vests the Parliament with absolute legislative authority and there are no limits whatever to the exercise of this power. Parliament can do everything and anything affecting the people and things. An act of the Parliament is binding law and the courts cannot in any way interfere with it. There is no judicial review of legislative action by the Parliament. The courts cannot invalidate an Act of the Parliament on the ground that if is against the so called natural law or that it is tyrannical, unreasonable, absured or bad. Acts of the Parliament can be modified and repealed only by another Act of Parliament. However, the courts are not as helpless as it may appear. They do play an important role in this field. No word is simple for interpretation and courts are frequently called upon to interpret an Act of Parliament.
