God of shepherd and pastures, flocks and woods. He was represented as one with goats, legs, horns and ears. In a good wood, he was shown as piping merrily. Thus wood brought peace and happiness. But Pan sometimes became angry and stamped his foot. This gave out earthquakes, storms and other destructive forces of nature. Naturally people tried to appease such Gods. This fear and faith comes from ignorance of the natural processes. With the advent of science, such superstitions died their own death. People knew before time what was going to happen so they prepared themselves to face calamities. But some superstitions lay deep in his psyche. They continued to frighten him and made him kneel before these invisible powers.
